


Establishment of Interbull centre

Standards / publications etc. (board and GA)



- Services and operations of other Subcommittees
 - Service ICAR → mainly in contracting a service provider (examples ID testing, ..)
- ICAR is working on this structure because these activities rely heavily on the Chair and members of these SC (all volunteers)

Operations ICAR <-> Interbull II

Operations of Interbull

- Done mainly by staff of the IB centre
 - ITBC staff is employed with SLU
 - Protection shield of Interbull / ICAR via the Swedish state
 - So far good way to operate with high quality staff

Budget

- Service fees under the responsibility of the IB SC
- Grants from Sweden / SLU
- EU contribution for role of ITBC/SLU as reference lab for EU bovine genetics
- All service money collected by ITBC

NTERBULL

Changing world



- Rapid development of new techniques
 - Animal identification
 - Data collection 'old traits'
 - New traits → how to get phenotypes
 - Sensors on farm
 - Genomic data available
 - Breeding programs changed within 5 years more than in 50 years before
- ICAR / Interbull can play an important role in this if there is a close collaboration between both

ICAR IB operations task force



- Business processes of ICAR and Interbull
 - Good starting point with a new CEO of ICAR and director of Interbull both starting in 2015
 - Cows under MR are basis for IB fees → no solid data since 3 years from ICAR

2. Connectedness

- Better setup / representation in SC, WG and TF of ICAR
 - Merger WG parentage, Genetic Analysis and new start of DNA WG
- Communication
 Interbull-ICAR Operations & Communications
 Committee, ICAR Pres + CEO, Interbull SC Chair and Director of ITBC

4. Governance

- Review existing agreements / contracts
- Get a clear understanding of the different situations,
 Having the same governance model likely not possible
- Dairy: all assets paid by dairy customers plus grants
 - Contracts between customers and ITBC
 - Full coverage of liability through SLU / Swedish state
- Interbeef: Initial investment by S-ICAR grants and then from Interbeef customers
 - Contracts of customers with S ICAR and IB center

GenoEX PSE

- Proposed 3 party agreement ??
- 2 party agreement S-ICAR customer or ITBC customer



Summary



- Good Progress on parts of the duties
- *8-9 months needed to complete the tasks
 - If minor changes with little effect to the relation between customer <-> ITBC are needed then the aim is to have Work completed in June 2017
 - If larger changes will be proposed then an intense discussion at the next business meeting in August 2017 will be needed
