

Interbull Guiding Principles

- 1. Opportunity/need for evaluation and validation of new phenotypes
- 2. Genomic based international evaluations
- 3. Maintain sound Interbull governance model
- 4. Provide excellent (current and new) services to current and new customers



Key short-term strategic issues

- 1. Improve Interbull governance model
- 2. Maintain MACE relevant
- 3. Establish a new R&D model supporting future developments
- 4. Identify and understand customer needs to add value to services
- 5. Implement new trait services
- 6. Develop a 'Data Hub' (genotype and phenotype)

MACE in the genomic era

Uses of MACE:

•To select confirmed bulls (less important than in the past)

- To validate GEBVs
- •As input for international and national genomic evaluations.
 - →Even if MACE is less visible than before, it is still an important tool.
 - \rightarrow Maintain relevance value of MACE is a key point

2 issues:

- Impact of Genomic pre-selection
- Interest in new traits and inclusion of female performances
 - Use MACE as it?
 - Extend MACE to females (\rightarrow proper method of de-regression)
 - Exchange female data directly (→ Interbull = hub?)



Needs for new developments and

research

Short term actions:

- Keep MACE relevant:
 - Robust MACE
- New tools for validation
 - Truncated MACE
 - Mendelian Sampling Test

Middle/long term actions:

- New traits, female ref. pop.:
 - How to include females?
 - New traits: complex traits → Multi Trait MACE?
- Single Step:
 - How to deal with (G)EBVs computed with Single Step?



How to organise changes?

- A time schedule must be announced in advance for each change (+ formats, procedures..) to have time to prepare the work
- Take time to share experiences with national centers before implementations of changes having a big impact (dedicated sessions in open meeting or workshops)
- Research projects: encourage collaborations between countries
